Entries:

PRE-ENTRY is compulsory for Show Jumping.

PRE-ENTRY is recommended for all other events.

HOW TO PRE-ENTER:

PRE-ENTRY is recommended for early classes **AS NO CLASS WILL BE HELD UP FOR LATE EXHIBITORS**. It is the responsibility of all exhibitors to arrive with sufficient time to enter their nominated classes. Prospective exhibitors should note that the Bungendore Show attracts in excess of 1200 horse exhibitors each year so there can be long queues for exhibitor tickets. For a stress free start to your show, it is strongly recommended that you PRE-ENTER. Rings will commence promptly, on time as per the times listed in this schedule.

PRE-ENTRY REFUNDS: On production of a doctor's certificate or a veterinary certificate, 75% of entry fees will be refunded.

Entries for Rings 1 to 11 and Sporting can be made on the morning of the Show at the Horse Entry Booth, which is open from 7.00am.

Equestrian Entry Costs:

\$5.00 per event for all Rings, excluding the Pony Club Ring - Pony Club Ring – \$2.00 per event

Sporting and Show Jumping entry fees as per this Schedule.

Show Entry Fees and Camping Fees also apply –

General Show Admission - \$15
(15 years & over)
Children under 15 years free

Camping is \$10 per site per night.
Powered camp sites are available in the designated horse yard.
There are plenty of hot showers and toilets within easy access of the horse yards.

All horse yards are uncovered and no yards will be reserved, yards available on a first comes basis. Horse yards are available free of charge.

Owners of Stallions are expected to be considerate of other exhibitors and to yard their stallions appropriately.

No electric fences are allowed on the showground.

All dogs are to be on leashes and secured at all times.

Notice to Exhibitors:

All exhibitors MUST WEAR an Australian Standard Approved Safety helmet when mounted while on the grounds of the Bungendore Show. This includes Hack & Australian Stock Horse Rings. Exhibitors in the Horse Section are advised that competitors in ring events will be called to the class by the Announcer or Ring Steward. Exhibitors in each class will be given a warning call, followed by an interval of a few minutes, then a final call will be made for the class. Failure of an exhibitor to report to the ring marshalling steward when called for a class shall render him or her liable to disqualification from that class. Should an exhibitor report late for the judging of a class, the exhibitor concerned shall only be allowed to enter the judging ring at the discretion of the Judge. Unless otherwise specified, stallions may only compete in stallion classes.

Reserve Champion Awards:

An exhibitor (or rider) placed second in a class to an exhibitor (or rider) selected as Champion, shall become eligible for a Reserve Champion ribbon, providing such second prize winner is available to enter the judging ring immediately after the Judge has selected and decorated the Champion. Exhibitors are warned that our ring program does not allow for any delay in the judging rings and stewards are not required to wait for exhibitors who fail to present their exhibits to the Judge when called.

LOCAL: All events identified as "LOCAL" are for exhibitors (horse, handler & rider) who reside within a 40km radius of Bungendore.

NOVICE: Novice events are for horses that have not won a FIRST ribbon at an Agricultural Show.

Ponies or Horses must nominate in either **Show Hunter Classes or Hack Classes**. Ponies or Horses nominated as Show Hunters may however compete in the Local classes.

Horses in appropriate classes must be registered with their Breed Society(s) and copies of Registration must be available for presentation on the day if requested by the relevant Judge or the Chief Horse Steward.

Drug Testing: An exhibitor shall not administer and shall not allow to be administered to their exhibit any drug or substance listed as a prohibited substance under EA rules. It is the intention of this rule that all animals shall perform on their merits without the aid of drugs which will affect the conduct, performance or appearance of the animal.

Offensive Behaviour: Offensive behaviour will not be tolerated from any person at the Bungendore PA & H Society Show. The BPA&H Society will be the sole judge of what constitutes offensive behaviour, but it may include but is not limited to making loud comments, the use of foul language or the intimidation or bullying of exhibits, exhibitors, officials, volunteers or spectators.

Cruelty to Animals: No exhibitor shall engage in or be knowingly involved in cruelty to any animal. The BPA & H Society will be the sole judge of what constitutes cruelty. Any case of cruelty must be reported immediately to the Chief Horse Steward.

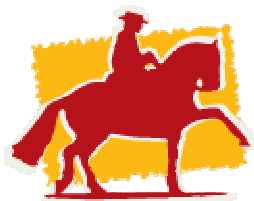

EVENT RULES

Bending Race

Competitors must leave the first peg on their right and proceed to bend up through the five pegs, turn at the top around the last peg and bend back through the pegs and across the start/finish line.

Elimination occurs if:

1. A competitor interferes with another competitor, horse or line of pegs. Competitors must keep within their lane. Should a competitor interfere with another competitor, horse or line of pegs, the race will be stopped as speedily as possible and re-run, but the competitor causing the infringement will be automatically disqualified.
2. A competitor causes more than one (1) false start.
3. A competitor knocks down any of the pegs.

Flag Race

Each competitor must leave the pegs on his/her right and take the furthest flag from the furthest peg first and place it in the cask/bucket/bag at the start line, then second furthest peg and continue in that sequence. The cask/bucket/bag can either be turned out or in.

Elimination occurs if:

1. A competitor interferes with another – same rule as for the Bending Race.
2. A competitor causes more than one (1) false start.
3. A competitor fails to correct a fallen cask or dropped flag. A fallen cask must be re-erected before the rider continues. A dropped flag must be picked up and the rider must re-mount before placing the flag in the cask.
4. Hitting the horse with a flag.
5. Picking up the peg with the flag.

Barrel Race

Riders may go to either right or left barrel first, but must make one left hand turn and two right turns, or one right turn and two left turns. A flying start is allowed. Horses are timed on the nose crossing the starting and finishing line. A 5 second penalty is incurred for:

- a) each barrel knocked over;
- b) each barrel touched with a hand.

Elimination occurs if:

1. The prescribed racing patterns are not followed.
2. Excessive hitting of the horse with spurs, whips or any object whatsoever.
3. The carrying of a whip in the mouth.

Western Bending Race

On the signal to start, the competitor rides through the start and straight to the 5th peg, keeping all pegs on their right hand side, rounds the 5th peg and proceeds to bend back through the pegs towards the start, rounding the 1st peg on their right hand side and immediately bending back up to the 5th peg, rounding the 5th peg on their right hand side and then riding straight back through the start finish line, all pegs on the run home being on the riders right hand side.

Elimination occurs if:

1. A competitor knocks over a peg.
2. A competitor deviates from the prescribed course.
3. A competitor causes more than one (1) false start.
4. A competitor touches a peg with their hand.
5. A competitor interferes with another – same rule as for the Bending Race.
